- §1 The Commodore Sulev Küünarpuu opened the meeting.

Latvia is responsible even if the races must be moved to Estonia.
- **Yearbook 1994**. Everybody was very satisfied with the yearbook, and agreed that it is the best way to inform about the class and its activities. It was printed in 1200 copies, and distribution works good.

- Official plans must be printed in the yearbook
- More photos
- List of contact persons of all member countries
- More advertising (income for IM-XVIYRA)
- Information about organisers/firms who helped/paid for the championship.
- Colorphoto on front-page. (How much?)

The board should work on it during the summer.
